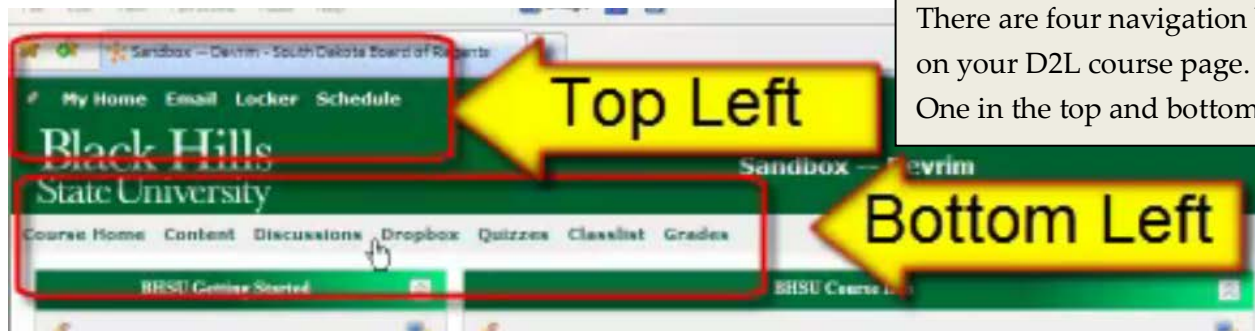


How to Activate New Tools in D2L

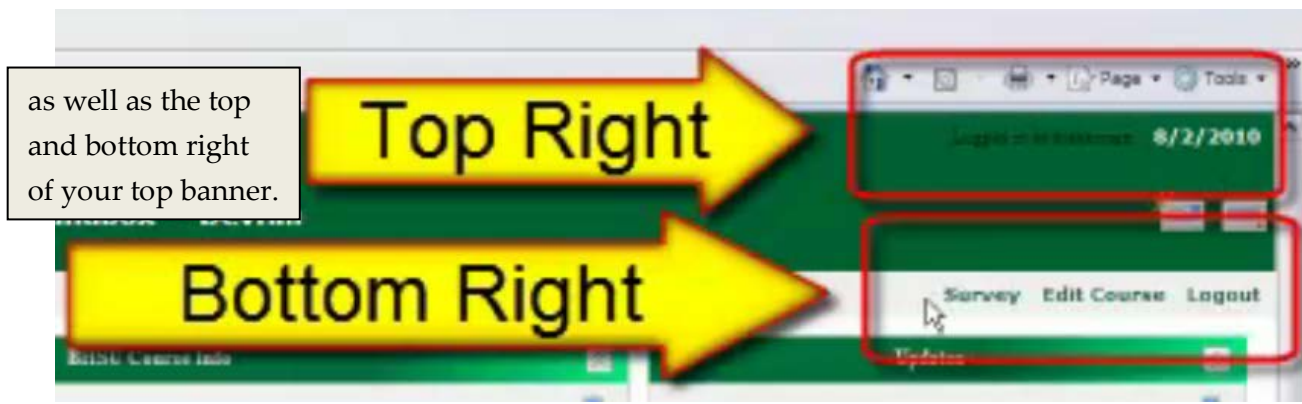
In this tutorial we will learn how to change the navigation bar in your D2L course. This is useful because you can change or add links that you think are important for your course. We will do this by adding two links to our navigation bar: the rubrics and competency and checklist links.

Step 1. Locating Navigation Bars

The navigation bar is used to help you quickly jump to a section in your D2L course.



There are four navigation bars on your D2L course page. One in the top and bottom left

2A. The first step in changing the navigation bar is to click on “edit course” on the bottom right navigation

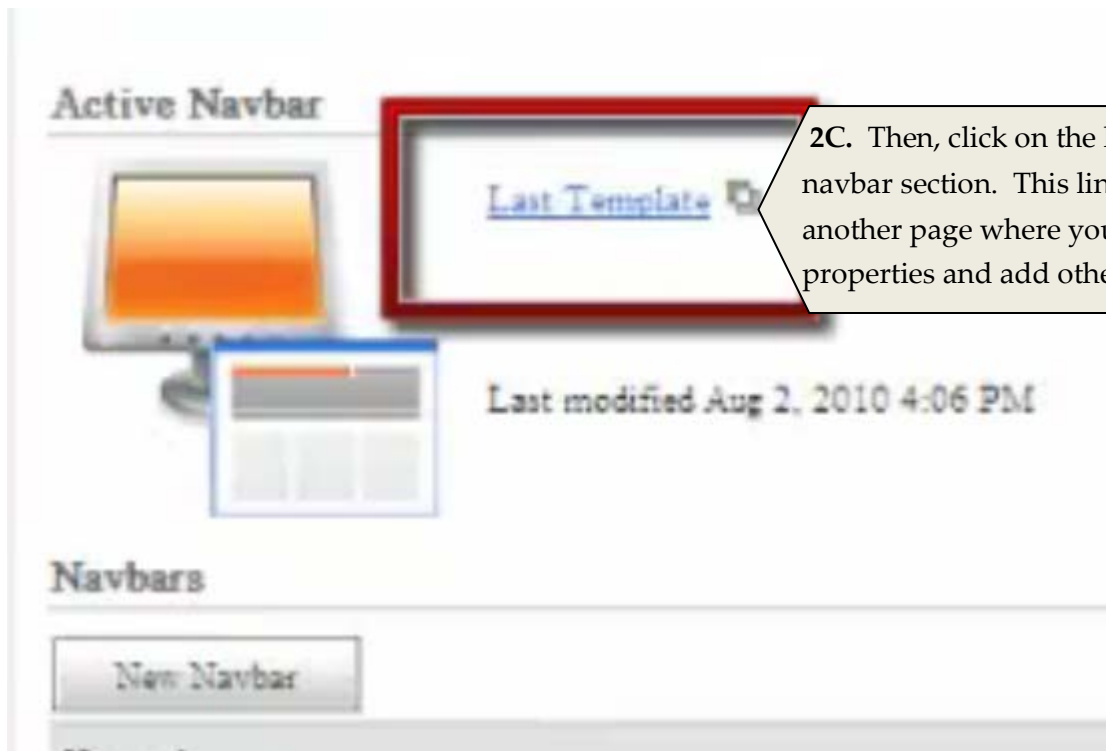

Select a homepage to use for this course offering, edit the appearance of the current homepage, or create custom widgets for the homepage.
