

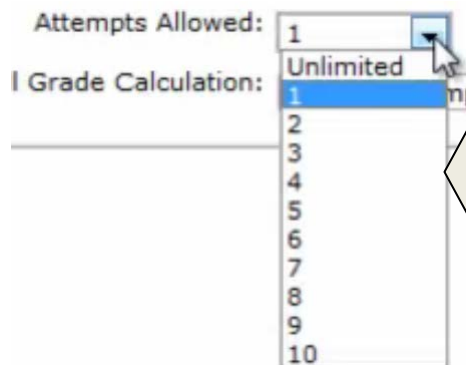
Attempts Tab in Quizzes

In this tutorial we will learn about the attempts tab.

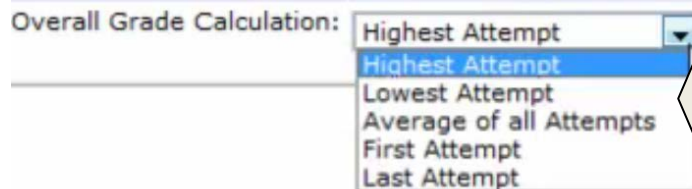


1. Click on the attempts tab.

On this tab you will see two drop down arrows.



2. The first drop down arrow specifies the number of attempts allowed. You can pick 1-10 attempts or an unlimited number of attempts.



3. The second drop down arrow specifies which attempt will be used to calculate the grade. You can choose the highest or lowest attempt, the average of all attempts, or the first or last attempt.



4. Click save when you have finished.

If more than one attempt is allowed, students can continue taking the quiz until all attempts have been used. For quizzes with multiple attempts, an overall grade is determined based on the overall grade calculation drop down box. The overall grade is the one that will be sent to the grades section. Regardless of the selected overall grade calculation option, the students may be able to see their scores for each attempt. The students will be able to see their performance and relevant score depending on the submission view properties the instructor has set.

Advanced Attempt Conditions

To restrict access to attempts, enter a minimum and/or maximum percentage (0 - 100) that needs to be achieved on the previous attempt to qualify for another attempt.

If the minimum and/or maximum percentage is left blank, it will not apply. If both are left blank, then there is no restriction.

Attempt 2 - Min: % Max: % on Attempt 1

Attempt 3 - Min: % Max: % on Attempt 2

Attempt 4 - Min: % Max: % on Attempt 3

5. Please note that once you assign between two and ten attempts, the rest of the page will change accordingly. Here you can assign a minimum and maximum percent achieved on one attempt to receive another attempt.

This is optional, so if you leave the section blank students will be allowed their attempts regardless of the previous percentage attained. For example, if you set a minimum score of 50% and a maximum score of 100%, if a student receives a 70% he/she will be allowed another attempt. If the student received 40%, he/she will not be allowed another attempt.
