

Image Information for Multiple Questions

In this tutorial we will learn how to create image information for multiple questions. This type of image is used as a reference for other questions throughout the quiz.



Use this to answer question 1 and 2.

Please use caution when you are using image information with random questions.

Step 1. Image Information

1A. First, select the image information type in the question library

1C. You have the option to enter a title but if you don't enter a title your caption will automatically be the title of the image.

We recommend you to enter a title that way the title will help you to distinguish the particular image from other images.

Acceptable file formats for images are jpeg, gif, bmp, and png.

1D. The description box will allow the instructor to enter a description for the image. This way those who have a visual impairment will be able to get information about the image using screen reader software.

Step 2. Ways to Save and Preview Work

At the top and bottom of your page you can click the preview, save, save and copy, or save and new button.

Preview

2A. The preview button can be used to see the question from the student and instructor's perspective for grading purposes.

Save

2B. If you are planning to create a different type of question after this one, click the save button.

Save and Copy

2C. If you would like to create another image information question with a similar question text click the save and copy button.

2D. If you would like to create a new image information question with different information click the save and new button.
