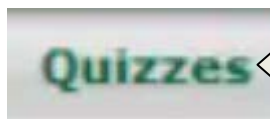


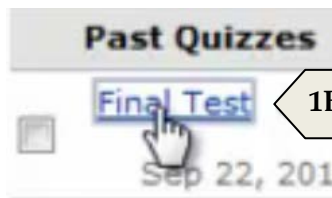
Creating Random Questions in Quizzes

In this tutorial we will learn how to create random questions. In order to create random questions you need to create a quiz, to learn more about creating quizzes please watch the tutorials on the right about setting up the quiz. Random questions can only be created in quiz's question library, not the main question library.

Step 1. Setting up Random Questions



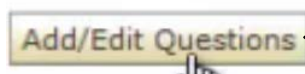
1A. To choose a random section first go to the quizzes tab



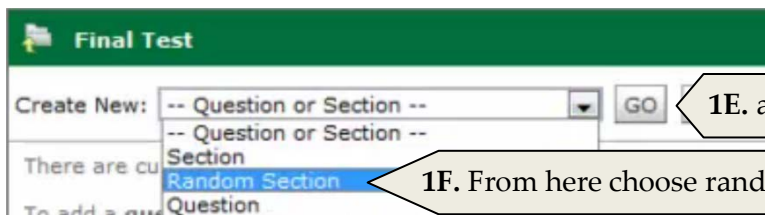
1B. choose a quiz that you have already created,



1C. click the layout questions tab,



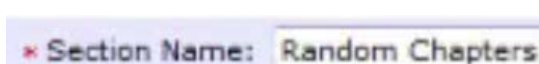
1D. and then click on add/edit questions.



1E. and click go.


1F. From here choose random section from the drop down menu


If you don't see a random section in this menu, it means you are in the main question library.



1G. A new screen will appear where you will need to name the section.

Step 2. Display Options

You can also modify the display options.

Options

show section name

insert a line break after section name

display message and image

display section message and image once

repeat section message and image before each question

2A. When you choose to show section name, the section name you entered above will appear at the top when your students start the quiz.

2B. Inserting a line break after the section name will emphasize the beginning of a new section in the quiz.


2C. When you display a message and image you can decide to display them once or to repeatedly display them before each question.


2D. Feedback is visible to students after the completion of the exam. In order for students to see feedback, show answers must be selected in the submission view and your students can see this by clicking the submission view button.

On the main screen you will see a folder; this is the random section you just created.



3C. You will choose which source to pull the questions from in the drop down arrow. The collection root will display everything you have created in the main question library.




Source Collection: Question Library


3D. From here, choose which questions or folders you want to include in this random section.

Step 4. Choosing How Many Questions

You will then see that your folder now contains the questions you selected.

At the top of the screen you will see that you can choose the number of questions to choose randomly from the list and state how much each questions is worth.

4A. To add more questions to this folder click import.

4B. Once you have chosen the number of questions you want to add to the section as well as how much each question is worth, click save.
